

Are you a professional migrant living in Western Australia?







The free Kaleidoscope Initiative provides:

- Five-day Workplace Readiness Training Workshops.
- 12 weeks of one-on-one professional mentoring for migrants of any visa background wanting to reconnect with their chosen field in WA.

Workplace Readiness Training

Day 1: Career Strategy. Create an individual career strategy, based on your personal goals and needs. Refine your job seeking skills to be suitable to the Western Australian context.

Day 2: Australian Workplace Cultures. Explore important rules, boundaries and expectations.

Day 3: Workplace Communication & Networking. Learn how to interact comfortably with others in a range of industry settings. Develop your Career Strategy and CV.

Day 4: Job Interview Skills. Build your confidence and communication skills for presenting professionally at a job interview.

Day 5: Rights at Work. Explore your legal rights as an employee in Australia.

During this five-day course you will:

- Qualify for the Kaleidoscope Mentoring Program upon completion
- Develop on your Career Strategy and CV (Resume) and receive personalised feedback
- Hear from specialist guest speakers
- Apply and practice job interview, workplace networking and other personal skills
- Receive free entry to two follow up one- day courses, (valued at \$630 per participant with over 100 courses to choose from)
- Receive a personalised Certificate of Achievement suitable for including with a job application.

To be suitable and eligible for the Kaleidoscope Initiative, you must be:

- A migrant of any visa background living in Australia for less than 10 years
- · Entitled to work and study in Australia
- Confident in written and spoken English, and
- Unemployed or underemployed, or not employed in your formal profession.
- · Currently reside in Western Australia

Kaleidoscope Mentoring Program

The Kaleidoscope Mentoring Program (KMP) will help you connect locally with your profession and improve your employment potential by matching you with a mentor from your industry or occupation.

Over the 12 week one-on-one mentor program you will:

- receive industry-specific guidance to help you build professional networks
- · increase your knowledge of recruitment practices
- · gain a better understanding of your profession locally
- receive advice on developing strengths and overcoming weaknesses
- · be guided on professional development and advancement
- increase your visibility and recognition within the professional networks
- · gain opportunities to develop new skills and knowledge.

Mentee eligibility:

- · have completed the Workplace Readiness Training
- can commit to the full 12-week one-on-one mentoring program
- are "job-ready" this means you are ready to start a job in their field, in Australia, at any given time
- have limited (< 1 year) or no Australian work experience in your profession/industry are currently unemployed or underemployed (i.e. not working in your field of expertise) have full work rights in Australia.
- have lived in Australia for ten years or less.
